Your itinerary

October 5 Our journey begins with a flight to the Holy Land (Tel Aviv).

October 6 Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, we'll make our way to the baggage claim area and collect our luggage. We'll proceed to the arrival's hall, where we will be greeted by our tour guide and driver. Transfer to our hotel in Tel Aviv to check-in. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight Tel Aviv

October 7 We will visit Caesarea, the Roman capital of ancient Israel, where St. Paul was imprisoned. After that, we will make our way to Mt. Carmel where we will visit the Church of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and Elijah's Grotto. Next, we will visit Nazareth, hometown of Jesus, followed by Cana, where Christ performed his first miracle. Overnight Nazareth

October 8 We will sail the serene waters of the Sea of Galilee before we visit Capernaum, where Jesus performed most of his public ministry. We will travel to the Mount of Beatitudes, visit the Church of the Fishes and Loaves, and stop at Yardenit, the Baptismal site on the river Jordan. Overnight Nazareth

October 9 We will visit Mt. Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration, following this we will journey to Jericho, the oldest known city. Next, we'll continue to Jesus' baptismal site on the Jordan River where you will have the opportunity to renew your baptismal vows. We finish out the day with a visit to Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered as we'll as a visit to the Dead Sea. Overnight Jerusalem

October 10 Today we will tour Jerusalem beginning with the Mount of Olives. We will visit the Church of Pater Noster and the Chapel of Ascension. Next, we will travel the Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane, where Christ prepared for his passion, and visit the Church of All Nations. We stop in Bethany, home of Mary, Margaret and Lazarus, and Bethlehem to see the Shepherd's Field, Church of Nativity, and the Manger where Jesus was born. Overnight Jerusalem

October 11 Enter old Jerusalem through St. Stephen's Gate, and visit the Wailing Wall and the Temple Mount. We will visit the Church of St. Anne and view the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus restored the blind man's sight. We will walk "the Way of the Cross" concluding with a visit to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. We will see the Model City of Jerusalem as it was during the Roman occupation. Time on your

own. Overnight Jerusalem

October 12 We will visit Mt. Zion and see the Upper Room, revered as the site of the Last Supper, and the Tomb of King David. We will visit the house of High Priest Caiaphas, where Jesus was imprisoned for a night, and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu where the Apostle denied Jesus three times. We will end our Israel pilgrimage this evening with a farewell dinner together. Following dinner, we will transfer to the airport in Tel Aviv for our flight home. *(Our optional Greece pilgrimage begins tonight with a short flight to Athens where we will be greeted by our Canterbury Tour Manager and brought to our hotel. Overnight Athens)*

Optional Greece Extension

October 13 Full day in Athens. We will see many of the ancient ruins such as; the Acropolis, the Parthenon, the Erechtheum, and many more. We will also see modern Greece, such as; the House of Parliament, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Palace, etc. Overnight Athens

October 14 We board our beautiful cruise ship provided by Celestyal Cruises and we will sail to the sublime island of Mykonos for a day of leisure. Be sure to see the famous windmills. Overnight aboard Cruise Ship

October 15 Today we will visit Rhodes, also known as the Island of the Knights. We will see the impressive fortifications of the old medieval town and venture on to see the Acropolis of Lindos. Overnight aboard Cruise Ship

October 16 Today we will travel to Turkey to see the ancient Greek City of Ephesus, where St. Paul spent two years during his ministry. We will visit the ruins of St. John's Basilica, where it is believed the "disciple whom Jesus loved" is buried. We will also see the Temples of Diana (Artemis), one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. We will sail to the island of Patmos, where St. John wrote the Book of Revelation. Overnight aboard Cruise Ship

October 17 After disembarking the ship, we will have a leisure day in Athens. We gather tonight for dinner. Overnight Athens

October 18 With a revitalized love of our Catholic faith, we will board our plane for our return flight home.

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and final Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Final payment is due 75 days prior to the departure date. Payment can be made by credit card or check. Credit card payments are subject to a 3% processing fee. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Cancellation fees: If cancellation in writing is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 75 days prior to departure all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee. For cancellations received less than 75 days prior to departure, the initial deposit of \$450 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours will be non-refundable. Please note that the amount may vary with each pilgrimage and the vendors we work with. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any pilgrimage up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned within 10 business days.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the pilgrimage. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance may apply)
