September 18: Our pilgrimage begins today with an overnight flight from Los Angeles to Paris. Meals will be served onboard.

September 19: Upon arrival in Paris we will be received by our Canterbury Pilgrimages tour manager, who will accompany us throughout the trip. We will continue to the center of Paris for a panoramic walk through some of the most important places in the City. We will see the Champs Elysees, the Arc de Triomphe, the Invalides and the Eiffel Tower. Overnight in Paris.

September 20: Today we will visit the Sanctuary of the Miraculous Medal where the Virgin appeared to St. Catarina Laburé. Free time for lunch. We continue to Ponte de Alma for a beautiful boat ride on the Seine River and end our afternoon visiting the Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Dinner in the center of Paris followed by a visit to the illuminated Eiffel Tower. Overnight in Paris.

September 21-22: Today and tomorrow we have free time to visit Paris on our own. Overnight in Paris.

September 23: Morning tour of Paris. Free time to climb the Eiffel Tower (optional) and in the afternoon we will go to the airport to fly to Toulouse. Overnight in Lourdes.

September 24: We will follow in the footsteps of Saint Bernadette today, starting with a visit to the Grotto of the Apparitions, the basilica and the mill where Bernadette's parents lived and worked. Afternoon free to purify yourself in the miraculous waters. After dinner, we'll participate in the Rosary and candlelight procession. Overnight in Lourdes.

September 25: In the morning we will travel to Madrid, Spain, passing the Pyrenees and appreciating its dazzling landscape. Arrival in Madrid, if time permits we will take a panoramic tour of the City. Overnight in Madrid.

September 26: We will leave for Toledo this morning, a powerful city of 3 cultures, a World Heritage Site that keeps in its walls the witnesses of the Jewish, Muslim and Christian presence. We will visit the Plaza del Ayuntamiento, the Toledo Cathedral, the Mosques of Christ de la Luz and the Synagogue of Santa María la Blanca (exterior). In the afternoon we will return to Madrid and visit by bus the most famous squares and streets of Madrid, Plaza Cibeles, Gran Vía, Puerta de Alcalá, and Plaza de España. Free time to enjoy the lively Plaza del Sol, the heart of Madrid. Overnight in Madrid.

September 27: Today we enjoy free time to visit Madrid on our own. Overnight in Madrid

September 28: We will leave for Fátima, Portugal. Along the way we will visit the walled city of Ávila, land of Saint Teresa, reformer of the Carmelite order and founder of many convents throughout Spain. We visit the church built in the birthplace of Santa Teresa. Overnight in Fatima.

September 29: We will participate in the official ceremonies of the centenary of the Apparitions of the Virgin to the Little Shepherds. We will visit the Sanctuary, the Basilica del Rosario with the tombs of the visionaries and the Basilica of the Holy Trinity. In the afternoon we will visit Valinhos where the Angel of Portugal appeared. We will also visit the houses of the little shepherds in the place of Aljustrel. After the visits we will be received by a family from the village for a tasting of Port wine and traditional products. Tonight we participate in the Rosary and Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Fatima.

September 30: In the morning we transfer to the Lisbon Airport to board our flight back to the United States, not without first treasuring in our unforgettable memories lived during this pilgrimage.

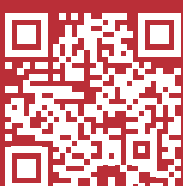

Terms of Service

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 75 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 75 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 75 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 75 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 75 days prior to the original departure date.

Cancellation fees: If the traveler's written notice of cancellation is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 75 days prior to the original departure date all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee. For cancellations received 75 days or less prior to the trip; departure, the initial deposit of \$450 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours will be non-refundable. Please note that the amount may vary with each pilgrimage and the vendors we work with. In the event of postponement, the above still applies. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any pilgrimage up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned within 10 business days.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the pilgrimage. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance may apply)

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident/illness/injury/trip cancellation/baggage insurance). Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. disclaims responsibility for accidents, personal illness or injury, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control. All categories of insurance may be purchased from Canterbury as provided by Allianz Travel Insurance.
