A Holy Land Pilgrimage

 **October 15 - 27, 2024 (10 Days + 3-Day Extension)**

Itinerary (subject to change)

Tuesday, October 15 - Depart Boston (BOS) for Tel Aviv (TLV)
Depart Boston (BOS) for an overnight flight to Tel Aviv (TLV), Israel. Drinks and meals served on the flight.

Wednesday, October 16 - Arrival to Tel Aviv - Nazareth
Upon arrival in Tel Aviv, our professional escort will greet us and take us by deluxe motorcoach to our hotel in Nazareth. We will have an afternoon of leisure followed by dinner at our hotel. *Overnight Nazareth.*

Thursday, October 17 - Tabor - Nazareth - Cana
Following breakfast, we travel by motorcoach to Mount Tabor to visit the beautiful basilica and the rock under the altar where the Transfiguration took place. We then move on to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation for Mass at the Grotto. We finish our day with a visit to the house of the Holy Family underneath the Church of St. Joseph. We proceed to Cana to visit the Wedding Church where Jesus performed the first of His miracles: changing water to wine. Spouses may have the opportunity to renew their wedding vows here. Dinner. *Overnight Nazareth.*

Friday, October 18 - Sea of Galilee - Baptismal Site
Today, we enjoy a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to visit the Mount of Beatitudes, where our Lord gave the Sermon on the Mount. We then proceed to Capernaum to visit the house of St. Peter, the synagogue where our Lord preached, and the Church of St. Peter's Primacy where our spiritual director will have the opportunity to celebrate Holy Mass. We finish our day with a visit to the Jordan River. Dinner. *Overnight Nazareth.*

Saturday, October 19 - Acre - Stella Maris - Caesarea
After breakfast, we visit the Old City of Acre, then proceed to Haifa to visit Stella Maris Monastery and Elijah's Cave where our spiritual director will have the opportunity to celebrate Mass. We then continue along the coast to Caesarea to visit a Roman amphitheater and aqueduct. Dinner. *Overnight Bethlehem.*

Sunday, October 20 - Bethany - Jericho - Qumran - Dead Sea
Following breakfast at the hotel, we travel to Bethany to visit the Church and the Tomb of St. Lazarus where our spiritual director will have the opportunity to celebrate Mass. Next, we go to the Mount of Temptation and the sycamore tree that Zacchaeus climbed to view Jesus. We then move on to the Dead Sea area to see the caves at Qumran and have the opportunity to float in the

Dead Sea. Finally, we will have some time at leisure before dinner. Dinner. *Overnight Bethlehem.*

Monday, October 21 - Bethlehem - Shepherd's Field - Ein Karem
Today we visit Bethlehem and the Basilica of the Nativity where our spiritual director will celebrate Mass. We also visit the Grotto of Nativity and the Church of St. Catherine as well as the Caves of St. Joseph and St. Jerome underneath the church. We then proceed to the Shepherd's Fields, and to the village of Ein-Karem to visit the birthplace of St. John the Baptist and the Church of the Visitation. Dinner. *Overnight Bethlehem.*















Tuesday, October 22 - Mount of Olives - Mount Zion
Following breakfast, we start our day with a visit to the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. We will then proceed to the Church of Pater Noster, where Jesus taught his disciples how to pray. We continue to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Rock of Agony. Mass in the Garden of Gethsemane before visiting the Church of the Dormition Abbey, the Cenacle, the place of the Last Supper and Pentecost, and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Peter denied Christ three times. Dinner. *Overnight Bethlehem.*

Wednesday, October 23 - St. Anne's - Via Dolorosa - Holy Sepulcher
This morning, we visit the Old City of Jerusalem, starting with St. Anne's Church and the Pools of Bethesda. Following our lunch break, we will walk the Via Dolorosa through the markets of the Old City praying the Stations of the Cross. We end our day at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Farewell dinner and *overnight in Bethlehem.*

Thursday, October 24 - Departure
With a renewed sense of pilgrimage and an invigorated love of our Catholic faith, we will board our plane for our return flight home.

October 24 - 27: Visit the Red Sea, explore the ancient city of Petra, stand atop Mount Nebo, and much more on an optional pilgrimage extension to Jordan!

Terms of Service

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is non-refundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 90 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 90 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 90 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 90 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 90 days prior to the original departure date.

Cancellation fees: If the traveler's written notice of cancellation is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 90 days prior to the original departure date all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee. For cancellations received 90 days or less prior to the trip; departure, the initial deposit of \$450 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours will be non-refundable. Please note that the amount may vary with each pilgrimage and the vendors we work with. In the event of postponement, the above still applies. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any pilgrimage up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned within 10 business days.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the pilgrimage. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance may apply)

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident/illness/injury/trip cancellation/baggage insurance). Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. disclaims responsibility for accidents, personal illness or injury, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control. All categories of insurance may be purchased from Canterbury as provided by Allianz Travel Insurance.

Not Included: Gratuities, room service, laundry, telephone calls, and all personal expenses.

By signing this form to participate in this pilgrimage tour, you agree that the terms of the cancellation penalty will be binding upon you regardless of whether persons listed in the tentative itinerary and schedule of speakers are able to participate. CPT will not be responsible for any loss incurred by traveler, including lost days of the scheduled tour, due to a cancelled flight or other means and modes of transportation. Please investigate purchasing travel insurance as recommended, to cover any type of loss associated with cancelled air or other transportation.
