April 30 | Our Pilgrimage Begins

Today we embark on our pilgrimage with an overnight flight(s) from Phoenix (PHX) to Athens (ATH). Enjoy meals and refreshments served on the plane.

May 1 | Arrival in Athens

Upon arrival at Athens International Airport, we will meet our guides and drivers. We will be transferred to our hotel for dinner and an overnight stay. *Overnight Athens*.

May 2 | Meteora Monasteries

This morning, we will visit the famous Meteora Monasteries. Here, we will see the world-famous Byzantine monasteries perched precariously on summits of gray rock pinnacles of varied and beautiful shapes. Their history dates back to the 14th century when the monks sought refuge in the cliffside caves, then fled higher to build the original wooden shelters, which were later transformed into monasteries. We will continue to Athens for dinner and an overnight stay. Morning Mass will be held at the Catholic Church of Athens or at the hotel in Kalambaka. *Overnight Kalambaka*.

May 3 | Tour of Berea & Thessaloniki

After breakfast, we visit Berea where Saint Paul preached in the Synagogue (Acts 17:10-15). We see St. Paul's Bema where he addressed the local Jews in 54 AD. Continuing to Thessaloniki (Acts 17:1-9), we visit the agora where Paul preached and the House of Jason, his host. We also visit St. Demetrius Basilica and the Galerius Arch. Dinner and overnight in Thessaloniki. Mass at the Bema of Saint Paul in Berea. *Overnight Thessaloniki*.

May 4 | Tour of Philippi & Kavala

In Philippi (Acts 16:11-40), we visit "Lydia's Baptistry" where Lydia was baptized, and the site of Paul and Silas' imprisonment. Then, we head to Kavala (Ancient Neapolis), where Paul, Timothy, and Silas first landed. Dinner and overnight in Thessaloniki. Mass at Philippi at Lydia's St. Paul's Baptistry. *Overnight Thessaloniki*.

May 5 | *Morning Flight to Athens & Cruise Embarkation Sail to Mykonos* Early morning flight today from Thessaloniki to Athens. Upon arrival at the airport, we will be transferred to Lavrion Port for our cruise embarkation. First stop, the quaint isle of Mykonos, called the island of windmills. Experience the waterfront lined with shops and cafes and then stroll the charming walkways through a maze of whitewashed buildings before returning to the ship for dinner and evening entertainment. Mass at St. Barbara Catholic Church at Lavrion port (time permitting, if not on board). *Overnight aboard ship*.

May 6 | Ancient Ephesus & Patmos

Docking in Turkey, we will enjoy an included tour of Ephesus, the city

of the Bible and one of the largest restorations still in progress with miles of ancient treasures. Ephesus was once a thriving port town of 250,000 people. Today you can still see the spectacular excavations of the major streets in this ancient city including the Agora, the Odeon, the Library, and the Great Theatre. You will continue to the House of the Virgin Mary. Celebrate Mass here. This afternoon we will visit the Isle of Patmos, under statutory protection as a historic monument. Here we will have an included tour to see the fortified monastery of St. John and the cave claimed to be where John received the Revelation. Back on the ship. *Overnight aboard ship*.

May 7 | Island of Rhodes

All day docked at the island of Rhodes where Ancient Greece meets Medieval Times and the romance of the island! Optional shore excursion to the Acropolis of Lindos, the Bay of St Paul where Saint Paul docked with his boat and walking tour in the Medieval town. Mass at Saint Maria Catholic Church. *Overnight aboard ship*.

May 8 | Heraklion & Santorini

Crete is the largest and most rugged of the Greek islands. Take an optional tour to Heraklion and the fantastic ruins of the Palace of Knossos. Discovered in 1899 and partially reconstructed, the elaborate Palace is believed to be the mythical Labyrinth of King Minos and the seat of ancient Minoan culture. This afternoon visits the island of Santorini which is perhaps the most breathtaking of all the Greek Islands. The town of Thira where white-washed houses, narrow streets, open-air cafes and glittering boutiques cling to steep cliffs, is accessible by footpath, cable-car, or mule. Again, you will return to the ship for dinner and evening entertainment. Mass at the Catholic Church of Santorini. *Overnight aboard ship*.

May 9 | Corinth & Saint Paul

Visit Corinth (Acts 18:1-18), exploring the Archaeological Museum, Market Place, and Temples. Stand on the Bema where Paul preached and visit sites associated with Aquila and Priscilla. Return to Athens for Dinner and an overnight stay. Mass at the Bema of Saint Paul in Corinth. *Overnight Athens*.

May 10 | Athens & Saint Paul

Apostle Paul traveled to Athens (Acts 17:16-34), preaching at the Aeropagus. We visit the Acropolis, Mars Hill, and the Agora where Paul addressed the Athenians. See the Olympic Stadium and enjoy free time in Plaka. Dinner and overnight in Athens. Mass at the Catholic Church of Athens. *Overnight Athens*.

May 11 | Return home

With a renewed sense of pilgrimage and an invigorated love of our Catholic faith, we will board our plane for our flight home.

Terms of Service

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is nonrefundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 90 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 90 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 90 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 90 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 90 days prior to the original departure date.

Cancellation fees: If the traveler's written notice of cancellation is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 90 days prior to the original departure date all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee. For cancellations received 90 days or less prior to the trip,' departure, the initial deposit of \$450 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours will be non-refundable. Please note that the amount may vary with each pilgrimage and the vendors we work with. In the event of postponement, the above still applies. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any pilgrimage up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned within 10 business days.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs, the fees can be costly. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier.
