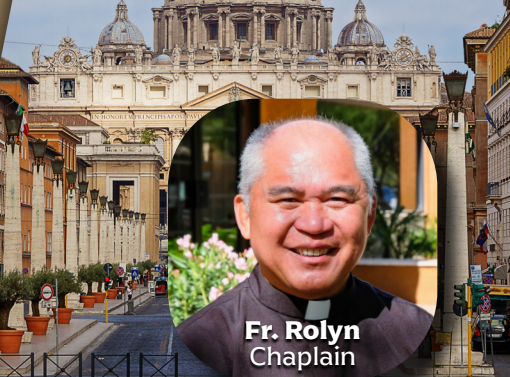


Jubilee Pilgrimage to Italy

Itinerary (Subject to Change)

October 1st - 11th, 2025

Day 1 | Wednesday, October 1st, 2025 | Departure for Rome

We depart Phoenix on our overnight flight to Rome, Italy. Drinks and meals will be served on board.

Day 2 | Thursday, October 2nd | Arrival in Rome

Upon arrival in Rome, we will gather our bags and meet our tour manager. We will board our bus and transfer to Florence to check in at our hotel before enjoying a welcome dinner for our pilgrimage in the evening. **Overnight in Florence.**

Day 3 | Friday, October 3rd | Cradle of the Renaissance

Today we wake up in the cradle of the Renaissance. After breakfast, we will start with a visit to the L'Accademia Museum to view Michelangelo's "David" as well as other works of art. Next, we're off to the Basilica di San Lorenzo, then continue through Republic Square to the Santa Maria del Fiore 13th century Cathedral. After Mass at the Cathedral, we'll depart for Assisi. **Dinner and overnight in Assisi.**

Day 4 | Saturday, October 4th | Assisi & Blessed Carlo Acutis

After breakfast, we begin our day in the lower village of Assisi, visiting St. Mary of the Angels, where St. Francis spent a significant part of his life. We will explore the Chapel Portiuncola, the rose bush, and the cave where the saint retreated for prayer. Next, we will proceed to the Church of St. Clare to view the Saint's body. We will have some free time for lunch at Piazza della Comune followed by a visit to St. Mary Major. We will also visit the Basilica of St. Francis where Father will celebrate Mass. Finally, we visit the Shrine of the Renunciation, where the millennial saint Blessed Carlo Acutis' body, and learn more about his life and spirituality. **Dinner and overnight in Assisi.**

Day 5 | Sunday, October 5th | Loreto, Lanciano, San Giovanni

Today we will make our way to San Giovanni, in route we will visit the town of Loreto and celebrate Mass at the Basilica della Santa Casa, housing The Holy House of Loreto. Continuing our journey, we will visit Lanciano, the site of the Eucharistic Miracle from the eighth century. Finally, we will head to San Giovanni Rotondo to visit the shrine of St. Padre Pio. **Dinner and overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.**

Day 6 | Monday, October 6th | Exploring St. Padre Pio's Life

Today is dedicated to the town where St. Padre Pio lived for most of his life. We will visit the church of Santa Maria Della Grazie, where the tomb of St. Padre Pio is located, and offer Mass. In the afternoon, we will visit the Sanctuary of Monte Sant'Angelo. **Dinner and overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.**

Day 7 | Tuesday, October 7th | Monte Cassino & Rome

All roads lead to Rome... Following breakfast, we set off on a scenic bus ride, heading to Monte Cassino, where the ancient Roman town of Casinum once stood. Our first stop is the Benedictine Abbey of Monte Cassino, the original home of the Benedictine Order, established by St. Benedict around 529. Here we will enjoy lunch and celebrate Mass. In the afternoon we will transfer to Rome. **Dinner and overnight in Rome.**

Day 8 | Wednesday, October 8th | Vatican City & Papal Audience

In the morning, we head to St. Peter's Square for the Papal general audience with Pope Francis (subject to his schedule). Afterward, we will have a private Mass nearby. Following a brief lunch, we tour the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel, and St. Peter's Basilica, marveling at the incredible art and history. Today we will be able to walk through the Holy Door at St. Peter's Basilica. **Dinner and overnight in Rome.**

Day 9 | Thursday, October 9th | Exploring Ancient Rome

After breakfast, we will embark on a historic tour of Ancient Rome. We will stroll along cobblestone streets, lined with majestic stone pines, and visit the Colosseum, a grand amphitheater of the ancient world. Along the way we'll stop for prayer at the Basilica of Saint Clement. Passing by the Roman Forum, we will witness the ruins of ancient government buildings. We'll finish the day visiting the Catacombs of St. Callixtus, a resting place of several popes from the 2nd to 4th centuries. Optional walking tour of the Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain and Spanish Steps this evening. **Dinner and overnight in Rome.**

Day 10 | Friday, October 10th | Major Roman Basilicas

Today we will visit and have an opportunity to walk through the Holy Doors at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, the Basilica of St. Mary Major, and the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran, which symbolizes passing into the presence of God by way of our Lord Jesus, who called himself the "gate." Those who pass through a Holy Door can also receive a plenary indulgence. At the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran we also will have the opportunity to climb the Lateran Steps and attend Mass. **Dinner and overnight in Rome.**

Day 11 | Saturday, October 11th | Our Pilgrimage ends

With a renewed sense of pilgrimage, and an invigorated love of our Catholic faith, we transfer to the Rome Fiumicino Airport and board our return flight home.

Terms of Service

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is nonrefundable (October be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 90 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 90 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 90 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 90 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 90 days prior to the original departure date.

Cancellation fees: If the traveler's written notice of cancellation is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 90 days prior to the original departure date all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee. For cancellations received 90 days or less prior to the trip, departure, the initial deposit of \$450 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours will be non-refundable. Please note that the amount October vary with each pilgrimage and the vendors we work with. In the event of postponement, the above still applies. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any pilgrimage up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned within 10 business days.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the pilgrimage. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance October apply)

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident/illness/injury/trip cancellation/baggage insurance). Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. disclaims responsibility for accidents, personal illness or injury, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control. All categories of insurance can be purchased from Canterbury as provided by Allianz Travel Insurance.

Not Included: Lunches, travel insurance, all personal expenses, tips for bus driver and Tour Manager, 3% credit card processing fee ((Pay by mailed check, ACH, or Zelle to avoid this fee), and anything not mentioned as included.

Liability: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours, Inc., and their employees, shareholders, officers and directors (collectively "CPT") do not own or operate any entity which is to or does provide goods or services for your pilgrimage including, for example, lodging facilities, transportation companies, local ground operators, including, without limitation, various entities which October utilize the CPT name, guides, sightseeing companies, entertainment, food or drink service providers, equipment suppliers, etc. As a result, CPT is not responsible for any negligent or willful act or failure to act of any person or entity. In addition, CPT is not responsible for any negligent or willful act or failure to act of any person or entity they do not own or control, nor for any act or inaction of any other third party not under their control. Without limitations CPT is not liable for any direct, indirect, consequential, or incidental damage, injury, death, loss, accident, delay, inconvenience or irregularity of any kind which October be occasioned by reason of any act or omission beyond their control, including, without limitation any willful or negligent act, failure to act, breach of contract or violation of local law or regulation of any third party such as an airline, train, hotel, bus, taxi, van, local ground handler or guide, whether or not it uses the CPT name, financial default or insolvency of any supplier which is to, or does supply any goods or services for this trip. Similarly, CPT is not responsible for any loss, injury, death or inconvenience due to delay or changes in schedule, overbooking of accommodation, default of any third party, attacks by animals, injury or death while on activities sponsored by lodging facilities or by other third parties, sickness, the lack of appropriate medical care, evacuation to same, if necessary, weather, strikes, acts of God or government, acts of terrorism, or the threat thereof, force majeure, war, quarantine, epidemics, or the threat thereof, criminal activity, or any other cause beyond its control. Should any of the persons listed in the tentative itinerary and schedule of speakers be unable to participate in this event, every effort will be made to secure a substitute. Regardless of the participation of persons listed in the tentative itinerary and schedule of speakers the pilgrimage tour will proceed as scheduled on the dates listed. By signing this form to participate in this pilgrimage tour, you agree that the terms of the cancellation penalty will be binding upon you regardless of whether persons listed in the tentative itinerary and schedule of speakers are able to participate. CPT will not be responsible for any loss incurred by traveler, including lost days of the scheduled tour, due to a cancelled flight or other means and modes of transportation. Please investigate purchasing travel insurance as recommended, to cover any type of loss associated with cancelled air or other transportation. All travel involves risk of loss, injury and death. While CP takes the safety of its pilgrims as its highest priority, CP disclaims liability for any loss, injury, or death that October occur on its pilgrimages.
