Itinerary (Subject to Change)

April 20-29, 2025

Day 1: April 20, 2025 | Depart for Spain

Our Pilgrimage begins as we depart Atlanta on our overnight flight to Madrid, Spain.

Day 2: April 21, 2025 | Arrival in Madrid

Upon arrival in Madrid, we will collect our bags, meet our tour manager, and transfer to our hotel for check in. Dinner and **overnight in Madrid.**

Day 3: April 22, 2025 | Madrid & Sarria

After breakfast we will tour the beautiful capital of Spain. We will visit the Cathedral of Saint Mary the Royal and celebrate Mass. In the afternoon, we will board our bus and continue northward to Sarria, Spain. Once we arrive, we will have the option to enjoy some time at leisure or explore Sarria. Dinner and **overnight in Sarria.**

Day 4: April 23, 2025 | Sarria to Portomarin

Sarria to Portomarin: approximately 6 hours walk / 13.6 miles.

Today we begin our walk to Santiago de Compostela. Expect a peaceful walk in shady oak woods, pretty villages and on quiet country roads. We will pass the villages of Barbadelo and Ferreiros. When you arrive in Portomarin (550m), you can rest on one of the numerous terraces of the main plaza.

Overnight Portomarin.

Day 5: April 24, 2025 | Portomarin to Palas do Rei

Portomarin to Palas do Rei: approximately 6 hours and

15-minute walk / 15.5 miles. From the village, the Camino crosses the river Minho and climbs steadily uphill. On our way, we will be crossing Gonzar and passing the Church of Santa María, Castromaior. In Eirexe, the portal of the church features a beautiful sculpture of Daniel and animals, as well as a statue of Santiago de Peregrino inside. You will then arrive in Palas do Rei (565m). **Overnight Palas do Rei.**

Day 6: April 25, 2025 | Palas do Rei to Arzua

Palas do Rei to Arzua: approximately 7 hours walk / 18 miles.

Today, the Camino continues slightly downhill, passing the

village of Casanova and the village of Leboeiro. At Melide (454m), stop in one of the many restaurants to try some local specialties. Later, we will follow a forest track and cross several streams bringing us to the village of Boente with its church of Santiago. Next, we will see the medieval village of Ribadiso, and finally Arzua (389m). This small town has two churches that you can visit, Santa María and La Magdalena. **Overnight Arzua.**

Day 7: April 26, 2025 | Arzua to Rua-O Pino

Arzua to Rua-O Pino: approximately 5 hours and 15 minutes /

11 miles. This shaded section of the Camino will pass through woods, along streams and through sleepy villages. Take your time and visit the chapel of Santa Irena, with its unique statues of Santiago. The rest of the way to Rua/O Pino is on a good and quiet country road. Rua (310m) is one of the less crowded stopping points before Santiago de Compostela.

Overnight Rua O Pino.

Day 8: April 27, 2025 | Rua to Santiago de Compostela

Rua to Santiago de Compostela: approximately 5 hours and

20 minutes / 12.4 miles. The next stage will be Lavacolla where pilgrims traditionally wash in the river before reaching Santiago de Compostela. From the “Mount of Joy” you can see your goal – the Cathedral of Santiago! After a descent to the city (264m, population 80,000) you will be able to witness this UNESCO World Heritage Site up-close. **Overnight Santiago de Compostela.**

Day 9: April 28, 2025 | Santiago de Compostela

Today we will have an opportunity to walk a portion of the “Way of St. James,” followed by a guided tour of the Cathedral of Santiago de Compostela. Dinner and **overnight in Santiago de Compostela.**

Day 10: April 29, 2025 | Return home

With a deeper love for our Faith, great memories of our pilgrimage, we will take a train to Madrid and board our plane for our flight(s) home.

Terms of Service

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is nonrefundable (April be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 90 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 90 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 90 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 90 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 90 days prior to the original departure date.

Cancellation fees: If the traveler's written notice of cancellation is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 90 days prior to the original departure date all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee. For cancellations received 90 days or less prior to the trip, departure, the initial deposit of \$450 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours will be non-refundable. Please note that the amount April vary with each pilgrimage and the vendors we work with. In the event of postponement, the above still applies. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any pilgrimage up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned within 10 business days.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the pilgrimage. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance April apply)

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident/illness/injury/trip cancellation/baggage insurance). Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. disclaims responsibility for accidents, personal illness or injury, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control. All categories of insurance can be purchased from Canterbury as provided by Allianz Travel Insurance.

Not Included: Lunches, travel insurance, all personal expenses, tips for bus driver and Tour Manager, 3% credit card processing fee ((Pay by mailed check, ACH, or Zelle to avoid this fee), and anything not mentioned as included.

By signing this form to participate in this pilgrimage tour, you agree that the terms of the cancellation penalty will be binding upon you regardless of whether persons listed in the tentative itinerary and schedule of speakers are able to participate. CPT will not be responsible for any loss incurred by traveler, including lost days of the scheduled tour, due to a cancelled flight or other means and modes of transportation. Please investigate purchasing travel insurance as recommended, to cover any type of loss associated with cancelled air or other transportation. All travel involves risk of loss, injury and death. While CP takes the safety of its pilgrims as its highest priority, CP disclaims liability for any loss, injury, or death that April occur on its pilgrimages.
