## Day 1 | Monday, Sep. 15th, 2025 | Departure

Our pilgrimage begins with overnight flights from Syracuse to Rome. Dinner and breakfast are served on the plane.

## Day 2 | Tuesday, Sep. 16th | Arrival in Rome

Upon our arrival in Rome, our tour manager will greet us. Depending on our arrival time, we'll have lunch and visit Chiesa del Domine Quo Vadis, where St. Peter met the Risen Christ and asked, "Lord, where are you going?" Mass will be celebrated today. Dinner and overnight stay in Rome.

Day 3 | Wednesday, Sep. 17th | Vatican City, The Papal Audience After breakfast, we head to St. Peter's Square for the Papal Audience with Pope Francis. We'll visit the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel, and St. Peter's Basilica, walking through the Holy Door, which symbolizes entering God's mercy. We conclude the day with Mass at a nearby church, dinner and an overnight stay in Rome.

## Day 4 | Thursday, Sep. 18th | Major Roman Basilicas

Today we will visit the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, Tre Fontane Abbey, St. Mary Major, and the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran, the "Mother of all Churches," where we'll celebrate Mass and have the chance to climb the Lateran Steps. Lastly, we'll visit the Basilica di Santa Croce in Gerusalemme. Dinner and **overnight in Rome**.

## Day 5 | Friday, Sep. 19<sup>th</sup> | Monte Cassino

Following breakfast, we set off to Monte Cassino, a Benedictine Monastery founded by St. Benedict. We then proceed to San Giovanni Rotondo, where we check into our hotel before attending Mass at Santa Maria delle Grazie. Dinner and overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.

**Day 6 | Saturday, Sep. 20<sup>th</sup> | Sαn Giovanni Rotondo** Today we will visit Casa Sollievo della Sofferenza, the hospital founded by Padre Pio. We will return to Santa Maria delle Grazie to see the confessional where Padre Pio spent countless hours and the incorrupt body of St. Padre

Pio. We then board our motorcoach and travel to Monte Sant'Angelo. Mass will be celebrated in the grotto. In the evening, we will join the candlelight procession. Dinner and overnight in San Giovanni Rotondo.

Day 7 | Sunday, Sep. 21st | Eucharistic Miracle of Lanciano Today, we head to Assisi, stopping in Lanciano to celebrate Mass in the chapel and visit the Church of St. Longinus, known for its Eucharistic Miracle. After lunch, we continue to Loreto, where we encounter the beautiful Madonna of Loreto. Later in the day, we travel to Assisi. Dinner and an overnight in Assisi.

Day 8 | Monday, Sep. 22<sup>nd</sup> | Assisi & Blessed Carlo Acutis

After breakfast, we start our day with Mass at the Basilica di Saint Francesco. After lunch, we visit the Basilica di Santa Chiara (St. Clare). Next, we'll visit the Cathedral of San Ruffino, Chiesa Nuova, and San Damiano. We will also visit Santuario della Spogliazione to view the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis. Dinner and overnight in Assisi.

Day 9 | Tuesday, Sep. 23rd | La Verna, St. Francis of Assisi After breakfast, we explore the Basilica di Santa Maria degli Angeli, which houses the "Porziuncola." We then travel to La Verna, where St. Francis received the Stigmata. Here, we will celebrate Mass at the Franciscan Sanctuary, followed by leisure time for lunch. We'll then drive to Siena, dinner and an overnight in Siena.

Day 10 | Wednesday, Sep. 24th | The Miraculous Hosts of Siena Today we wake up in Siena. We will walk to Basilica San Francesco and celebrate Mass in the chapel that houses the Eucharistic Miracle. After lunch, our journey continues to Orvieto, a city perched atop a volcanic rock. Here, we will visit the site of the Eucharistic Miracle of Orvieto from 1263. Return to Rome for a farewell dinner. Overnight in Rome.

**Day 11 | Thursday, Sep. 25<sup>th</sup> | Depαrture**With renewed faith, we will board our flight for our return journey home, carrying the blessings of our pilgrimage.

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is nonrefundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: final payment is due 90 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 90 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 90 days prior to the new departure date.
