Day 1 | April 13, 2026 | Our Pilgrimage Begins

Today our pilgrimage begins as we depart the USA on an overnight flight(s) to Paris. Meals and refreshments served on the plane.

Day 2 | April 14, 2026 | Arrival in Paris

Upon landing in Paris, we will collect our bags then meet

our Canterbury tour manager and bus driver at the airport. We will board our bus and transfer to Lisieux. **Welcome dinner and overnight in Lisieux.**

Day 3 | April 15, 2026 | Normandy - Lisieux

After breakfast, we continue to Normandy to see Omaha Beach, where Allied troops stormed ashore to launch the D-Day invasion. We will have a break for lunch before returning to Lisieux. We will celebrate Mass at the Basilica of St. Thérèse and then visit the home and Carmelite Monastery of St. Thérèse, the "Little Flower." **Dinner and overnight in Lisieux.**

Day 4 | April 16, 2026 | Mont Saint Michel

Today we will visit Mont Saint Michel, perched on a rocky island in the Gulf of Saint Malo. Before exploring the commune and its Abbey, we will celebrate Mass in a local chapel. **Dinner and overnight in Mont Saint Michel.**

Day 5 | April 17, 2026 | Chartres

After breakfast, we will board our bus and head to Chartres. Upon arrival, we will celebrate Mass at the magnificent 13th-century Gothic Cathedral. Afterward, enjoy lunch and some time at leisure to visit Chartres on your own before continuing to Paris. **Dinner and overnight in Paris.**

Day 6 | April 18, 2026 | Paris

Today we will visit the Shrine of the Miraculous Medal on the Rue de Bac and celebrate Mass. Our Lady appeared to St. Catherine Labouré and asked her to have a medal made with the inscription, "O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee." Next, we'll visit Église Saint-Sulpice, the Shrine of St. Vincent de Paul, and the Church of St. Mary Magdalene. **Dinner and overnight in Paris.**

Day 7 | April 19, 2026 | Paris

Following breakfast, we will celebrate Mass in the Romanesque and Byzantine Sacré-Coeur Basilica on Montmartre Hill. We'll visit the Gallery of the Kings, its many chapels, and the Rose Window. We'll also visit the famous Cathedral of Notre-Dame de Paris. This afternoon, we will visit Sainte Chapelle and the Louvre Museum. **Dinner and overnight in Paris.**

Day 8 | April 20, 2026 | Nevers, Paray-le-Monial

Morning departure for Nevers, France. Upon arrival, we will celebrate Mass and visit the Convent of St. Gildard. Afterward, explore the town before journeying south to Paray-le-Monial to visit the Basilica of the Sacred Heart. **Dinner and overnight in Paray-le-Monial.**

Day 9 | April 21, 2026 | Ars, Journey to Lourdes

After breakfast, we will continue to Ars, home of the Basilica of St. John Vianney. We will celebrate Mass here before spending time in prayer before the incorrupt body of the saint. Next, we will head to Lyon and board a flight to Toulouse. This afternoon, we will drive to Lourdes and have time at leisure to visit the Grotto of Massabielle. We will take part in an evening candlelight procession. **Dinner and overnight in Lourdes.**

Day 10 | April 22, 2026 | Lourdes

Today our spiritual director will celebrate Mass for us at the grotto. After Mass, we will have a guided tour of St. Bernadette's home and the basilicas, gaining a deeper understanding of her life and relationship with Mary. This afternoon is free for adoration, personal prayer, or shopping. We will gather this evening for a Eucharistic Procession. **Farewell dinner and overnight in Lourdes.**

Day 11 | April 23, 2026 | Return home

With a deeper love for Mary, gratitude to God, and wonderful memories of our pilgrimage, we will transfer to the airport and board our flight(s) home.

Terms of Service

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is nonrefundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 90 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 90 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 90 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 90 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 90 days prior to the original departure date.

Cancellation fees: If the traveler's written notice of cancellation is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 90 days prior to the original departure date all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee. For cancellations received 90 days or less prior to the trip; departure, the initial deposit of \$450 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours will be non-refundable. Please note that the amount may vary with each pilgrimage and the vendors we work with. In the event of postponement, the above still applies. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any pilgrimage up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned within 10 business days.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the pilgrimage. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance may apply)

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident/illness/injury/trip cancellation/baggage insurance). Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. disclaims responsibility for accidents, personal illness or injury, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control. All categories of insurance may be purchased from Canterbury as provided by Allianz Travel Insurance.

Not Included: Lunches, tips for driver & tour guide (It is recommended that, so long as travelers are happy with the service they received, they tip their guide \$8-10 per person per day and their driver \$6-8 per person per day), travel insurance, all personal expenses, and anything not mentioned as included.

By signing this form to participate in this pilgrimage tour, you agree that the terms of the cancellation penalty will be binding upon you regardless of whether persons listed in the tentative itinerary and schedule of speakers are able to participate. CPT will not be responsible for any loss incurred by traveler, including lost days of the scheduled tour, due to a cancelled flight or other means and modes of transportation. Please investigate purchasing travel insurance as recommended, to cover any type of loss associated with cancelled air or other transportation. All travel involves risk of loss, injury and death. While CP takes the safety of its pilgrims as its highest priority, CP disclaims liability for any loss, injury, or death that may occur on its pilgrimages.
