Wed, May 14: Depart for Warsaw

Depart for an overnight flight to Warsaw, Poland. Dinner and breakfast provided on the flight.

Thu, May 15: St. Stanislaus Kostka Church & Niepokalanow

Arrive in Warsaw and meet our tour escort. Visit St. Stanislaus

Kostka Church before traveling to Niepokalanow to see the Franciscan Monastery founded by St. Maximilian Kolbe. Continue to Świnice Warckie to visit the Church of St. Casimir, where St. Faustina was baptized. Check into the hotel and enjoy a welcome dinner. **Overnight in Świnice Warckie.**

Fri, May 16: Mass at Jasna Góra & Black Madonna

After breakfast, travel to Częstochowa, one of Poland's most important pilgrimage sites. Celebrate Mass at Jasna Góra Monastery, home of the famous Black Madonna icon, a center of pilgrimage since the 14th century. Dinner in the evening. **Overnight in Częstochowa.**

Sat, May 17: St. John Paul II's Birthplace & Zakopane

Depart for Zakopane with a stop in Wadowice, the birthplace of St. John Paul II, to visit his childhood church. Arrive in Zakopane and visit Jaszczurówka Chapel, followed by free time to explore Krupówki Street. Dinner and fellowship. **Overnight in Zakopane**

Sun, May 18: Cable Car Ride, Hike, & Wieliczka Salt Mines

Enjoy a cable car ride to a nearby mountaintop, followed by a hike along trails that St. John Paul II frequented. Visit the Wieliczka Salt Mines en route to Kraków, then participate in Mass at the Skałka Shrine, dedicated to St. Stanislaus. Dinner. **Overnight in Kraków.**

Mon, May 19: Auschwitz & Calvary Sanctuary

Morning visit to Auschwitz concentration camp, including St. Maximilian Kolbe's cell. On the return to Kraków, stop at Calvary Sanctuary in Kalwaria Zebrzydowska to see the miraculous painting of Our Lady of Kalwaria. Dinner. **Overnight in Kraków**

Tue, May 20: Divine Mercy Shrine & John Paul II Centre

Visit the convent at Łagiewniki, where St. Faustina spent her final years. Pray before the Divine Mercy image and visit her tomb. Attend Mass at the shrine before visiting the John Paul II Centre. Dinner. **Overnight in Kraków.**

Wed, May 21: Wawel Castle & St. Mary's Basilica

Tour Kraków, including Wawel Castle, the Coronation Cathedral, and St. Mary's Basilica. Free time at the Market Square. Mass at St. Mary's. Dinner. **Overnight in Kraków.**

Thu, May 22: Flight to Munich & Altötting

Fly to Munich and travel to Altötting for Mass at the Chapel of Mercy, home of the Black Madonna statue. Visit St. Konrad's Monastery before heading to Salzburg, Austria. Dinner. **Overnight in Salzburg.**

Fri, May 23: Salzburg Walking Tour & Hellbrunn Palace

Breakfast and Mass at St. Peter's Abbey, followed by a walking tour of Salzburg's old town. Visit Mozart's birthplace, the Romanesque Cathedral, and Hellbrunn Palace. Dinner. **Overnight in Salzburg.**

Sat, May 24: Mariazell Basilica & Melk Abbey

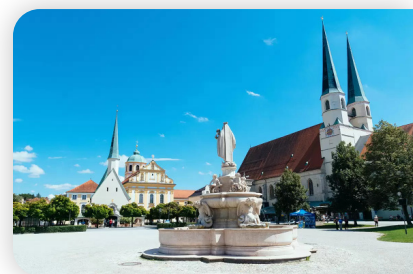
Depart for Mariazell, a renowned pilgrimage site in Austria, to visit the Mariazell Basilica. Continue to Melk to tour the Melk Abbey overlooking the Danube River. Travel to Vienna. Dinner. **Overnight in Vienna.**

Sun, May 25: St. Stephen's Cathedral & Schonbrunn Palace

Explore Vienna with a visit to St. Stephen's Cathedral, Schonbrunn Palace, Belvedere Palace, and St. Charles Borromeo's Church. Enjoy Viennese pastries and reflect on our journey. Dinner. **Overnight in Vienna.**

Mon, May 26: Return Home

Terms of Service

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and Payments: A deposit of \$450 per person is required to hold your reservation of which \$200 is nonrefundable (may be refundable under travel insurance conditions). Payment can be made by credit card or check. Call (800) 653-0017 to make a credit card payment.

Final payments: Final payment is due 90 days prior to the original departure date except in the case of postponement. The original departure date is a date of departure for which a new reservation is intended. In the event of postponement, if the decision of postponement is made sooner than 90 days prior to the original departure date, final payment will be due 90 days prior to the new departure date. If the decision of postponement is made 90 days prior to the original departure date or later then the payment remains due 90 days prior to the original departure date.

Cancellation fees: If the traveler's written notice of cancellation is received by Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. more than 90 days prior to the original departure date all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$200 processing fee. For cancellations received 90 days or less prior to the trip; departure, the initial deposit of \$450 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours will be non-refundable. Please note that the amount may vary with each pilgrimage and the vendors we work with. In the event of postponement, the above still applies. Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. retains the right to cancel any pilgrimage up to the departure date in which case all funds received will be returned within 10 business days.

Baggage: Please follow the general rule of traveling light - If you cannot carry it do not bring it. Passengers are permitted one piece of luggage per person. Baggage handling is included for one suitcase per person only, whenever possible, in the cost of the pilgrimage. The airlines for international flights will not allow a suitcase exceeding 50 pounds (subject to change), if over 50lbs., the fees can be costly. On inter-European flights, which are not directly connected to a transatlantic flight the baggage weight limit is lower. We will provide you with this information in the final travel documents. Baggage handling is not available on any of the trains. Every effort will be made to handle luggage carefully, however Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. will not assume any liability for lost or damaged luggage or items inside luggage carrier. (Travel insurance may apply)

Travel insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance (personal accident/illness/injury/trip cancellation/baggage insurance). Canterbury Pilgrimages & Tours Inc. disclaims responsibility for accidents, personal illness or injury, trip cancellations, or handling of baggage not under our control. All categories of insurance may be purchased from Canterbury as provided by Allianz Travel Insurance.

Not Included: Lunches, tips for driver & tour guide (It is recommended that, so long as travelers are happy with the service they received, they tip their guide \$8-10 per person per day and their driver \$6-8 per person per day), travel insurance, all personal expenses, and anything not mentioned as included.

CPT will not be responsible for any loss incurred by traveler, including lost days of the scheduled tour, due to a cancelled flight or other means and modes of transportation. Please investigate purchasing travel insurance as recommended, to cover any type of loss associated with cancelled air or other transportation. All travel involves risk of loss, injury and death.
